Jeff Sprowles of Wise, Buckner, Sprowles & Associates gave the audit report for the district for FY 15-16. He noted that the audit had a clean opinion. He noted that the general fund had \$173,088 increase in fund balance during the FY 15-16. The food service fund balance decreased \$41,634 but was not as much of a decrease as FY 14-15. He anticipated we should see growth in the program moving forward with full implementation of CEP in the elementary and middle school. Pension expense for KTRS increased, these numbers are based on numbers provided by KTRS audit reports. He noted financially this had been a good year for the district.
