## Rationale:

Mr. Higdon and Ms. Harris presented a District of Distinction award to Superintendent Cook. Only three districts in the state received this honor. This means that all schools were named a School of Distinction. Ms. Harris also noted that our biggest gain was ECE.

# H.VI. DiAnne Harris, Instructional Coordinator

### Rationale:

District state test scores were shared with the board members. The district is classified as a district of distinction, and each school is classified as a school of distinction, Kentucky's highest academic honor.

Many praises were given to the board members for supporting personalized learning, principals for implementing best practices with staff and students, and staff and students for all their efforts in reducing novice and promoting academic excellence.

TC is ranked 14 in the state this year with a 77.2 overall score. Program Review areas were proficient, accounting for 23% of the score. Gains were made in closing the achievement gap with ECE and Free/Reduced Lunch groups. Each school implemented common assessments at least three times last year, assessing students on standards, analyzing data, targeting novice students for interventions, and sharing data with staff and district personnel to determine next steps.
